Enclosed herewith is material which I submitted recently to Collier's, together with a copy of my letter to Mr. Chenery covering this material; and also a reply, for Mr. Chenery, from Denver Lindley.

There is one point which I want especially to emphasize:

The principle of my Chaocipher System is neither recondite nor abstruse - it is the very essence of simplicity.

Since that time in the long-pulverized past when one of the first pioneers in mechanical applied science had the bright thought of causing one wheel to rotate by contact with another, my principle has lain like a nugget of gold protruding from the roadside, almost pleading with the myriad passers by to pick it up.
